## GENERAL INFORMATION

**CONDUCT:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, trainer and spectator to conduct themselves in a civilized and sportsmanlike manner. All children must be accompanied/supervised by an adult.

**ENTRY FEES and DEADLINE:** Entry fee is \$15 per class if entry is received by Wednesday, February 29. All entries received after the deadline will be subject to a \$5 per class late fee. A \$15.00 office and awards fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. Once the show has started, proper notification of a scratch must be made to the show secretary BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched. Gambler's Choice entry fee is \$100. **CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE PRESENTED FOR ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS.**

**RETURNED CHECKS:** A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

**DOGS:** No dogs may be brought on property.

**ATTIRE: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED.** Riders must be properly attired. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. May wear solid color polo shirts with collars. Half Chaps may be worn. No helmets required for Western Dressage – Cowboy Hats may be worn.

**RIBBONS, PRIZES and CHAMPIONSHIP:** All classes receive a 1<sup>st</sup> place prize and 6 ribbons. Division Champion will receive ribbon & prize. Division Reserve Champion will receive ribbon. Series Championship Grand Prize will be awarded at the conclusion of Series. Must participate in all 2012 Heritage Series Shows to be eligible for Championship Grand Prize. Gambler's Choice entries are not considered in Division standings. Dressage Tests of Choice will be judged but no ribbons or prizes will be awarded.

**FOOTING:** Covered Arena is 100' x 200' with improved sand footing. Outdoor Jumping Arena is 250' x 350' with all-weather sand footing. Dressage Arena is 20x60 meters with improved sand footing.

**CHANGES:** Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be canceled.

**CONCESSIONS:** Available Sunday 7:00 am to conclusion of show.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless BuckBranch Farm against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. **Introducing an Exciting New Class!  
Gambler's Choice  
Benefiting SMU Equestrian Team**

This is an exciting event where the exhibitors choose their own course, with each fence cleared worth a given amount of points based on difficulty. The entry who accumulates the most points within a set time limit on course is the winner.

This class will run in the Jumper Ring at the end of each Division, so that riders at all height levels can have a chance to compete. Riders in all divisions will compete for the same prize money pot and will show at their specified height.

**Entry Fee is \$100**

**\$50 will go to the Prize Money Pot  
and  
\$50 will go to the SMU Equestrian Team Benefit Fund**

**The prize money pot will be divided as follows:**

**50% to First Place**

**(Plus a First Place Prize provided by SMU)**

**30% to Second Place**

**20% to Third Place**

Any rider entering the Gambler's Choice must also enter at least one other class in the show. One Gambler's Choice entry per horse and rider combination, and they must compete at the highest division entered.

Gambler's Choice Rules and Specifications will be posted, along with course maps showing points assigned to each fence.

Gambler's Choice Classes are not considered in Division Standings.

A compliance stipulation is that no SMU student athlete may participate.
